

Jairam Thakur: All MPs Joined to Meet Central Ministers Seeking Disaster Relief Assistance

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Shimla: Former Chief Minister and Leader of the Opposition, **Jairam Thakur**, stated that he, along with all Members of Parliament from the state, met **central ministers to seek urgent assistance for disaster-affected areas**.

Thakur highlighted that he had requested a discussion on disaster relief under **Rule 67 in the Assembly**, which the government accepted after pressure from the opposition. He accused the government of attempting to **claim the relief materials sent by the public as their own**, undermining the efforts of citizens and his party.

He further emphasized that **relief materials brought by the opposition party and state residents** are being directly distributed to those in need. Thakur called for **proper coordination between the state and central authorities** to ensure timely assistance reaches the affected communities.
