

Deepika's Daring Fringe Moment at LVMH

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Bollywood's global icon **Deepika Padukone** added yet another feather to her cap by making history as the **first Indian jury member** at the prestigious **Louis Vuitton (LVMH) Prize 2025**. The event, held in the City of Lights, witnessed her make a striking red carpet statement—adorning a fringe-laden ensemble that had fashion lovers both swooning and scoffing.

What Worked:

- Balanced styling: Accessories and makeup were classy—not overdone.

What Divided Audiences:

- Color palette: Some felt the brown tones dampened the glam factor.
- Over-the-top theatricality: The fringe skirt was seen by cynics as bordering on costume, not couture.
- Stylist scrutiny: The recurring earthy, abstract outfits raised questions about directional consistency.

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
