- **Samant Chauhan:** Chauhan modernized Bhagalpuri silk by incorporating hand embroidery, blending traditional fabrics with contemporary silhouettes.
- Suket Dhir & Anjali Kalia: Their collaborative collection captivated the audience with innovative designs that merged traditional techniques with modern aesthetics.

The event was inaugurated by Neelam Shami Rao, Secretary of the Ministry of Textiles, alongside Amrit Raj from DC Handicrafts. Their presence underscored the government's commitment to promoting and preserving India's rich craft heritage.
