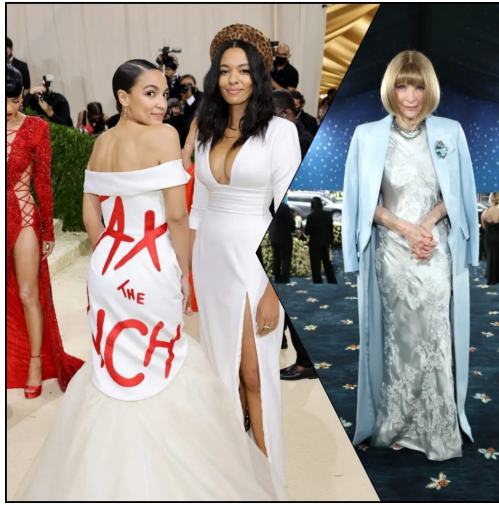


Anna Wintour Finally Reacts to AOC's 'Tax the Rich' Met Gala Dress

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Anna Wintour Speaks on AOC's Viral Met Gala Look

More than four years after **Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez's "Tax the Rich" gown** ignited a cultural firestorm at the **2021 Met Gala**, Vogue editor-in-chief **Anna Wintour** has finally offered her candid reaction.

In a recent interview, Wintour described the look as one of the most **memorable political fashion moments** in Met Gala history, adding that it perfectly embodied the evening's spirit of creative expression—even if it divided opinion.

"It was bold, it was unapologetic, and it sparked a conversation," Wintour said. "That, to me, is what fashion should do."
