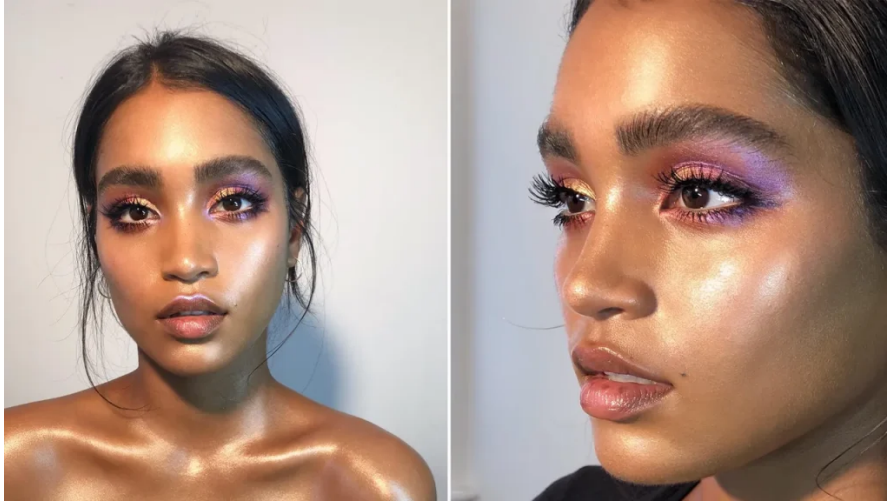


Mastering Highlighter Application for a Dewy Glow
