- **Bobo Calcutta** drew inspiration from architectural structures, particularly the pandal, to create fashion that envelops and embraces, symbolizing love at its core.
- **Gaurav Gupta** delved into surreal Indian mythology, presenting a brass sculpture of a hybrid bird-woman figure, merging elements of a swan, peacock, and snake.
- **Ashdeen** therefore Parsi gara embroidery into a dreamlike narrative, envisioning a 'Cloud Kingdom' inhabited by fantastical creatures.
