

From Catwalk to High Street: Pull&Bear Collaborates with Designer Marie Lueder

Lueder's London Fashion Week debut was made possible through Pull&Bear's collaboration with the **British Fashion Council (BFC)** as part of the *Canvas for Creativity* programme under the **NEWGEN initiative**, designed to champion emerging designers.

For Pull&Bear, the partnership marks a bold step in **bridging high-street accessibility with avant-garde design.**Lueder presented her **spring/summer 2025 collection**, *The Shell*, not only on the runway but also at Pull&Bear's new Oxford Street flagship, integrating her experimental vision into the Spanish label's global production and retail system.

The Lueder x Pull&Bear Collection

The joint line—now available via Pull&Bear's online platform—reimagines **contemporary wardrobe basics** with Lueder's unique codes. Expect clean silhouettes infused with medieval-inspired details, a subtle play of structure and softness, and an emphasis on pieces that balance **wearability with conceptual storytelling.**

With this collaboration, Pull&Bear continues to redefine high-street fashion, while Lueder amplifies her international presence by reaching a wider audience without compromising her distinct vision.
