

LFW SS26: Mithridate Captures the ‘London Look’ with Britcore Aesthetic

London Fashion Week Spring/Summer 2026 was buzzing with bold statements, but Mithridate's collection by Daniel Fletcher stood out as the true definition of this season's 'London Look'.

Though based in Guangzhou, China, Fletcher's second collection for Mithridate tapped directly into **British heritage and London's street-smart energy**. The result? A collection that perfectly captured the rising fashion movement known as '**Britcore**' — where countryside charm meets urban grit.

The Essence of Britcore

Mithridate's SS26 lineup was a seamless mix of preppy and edgy: **rugby shirts, Harrington jackets, tuxedo blazers** and **masculine footwear**, contrasted with **sequined skirts, feminine details, and delicate flourishes**. This duality highlighted the **tension between tradition and rebellion** that defines the London aesthetic today.

Key Looks on the Runway

- **Look 11:** A cropped, double-collared rugby shirt styled with a classic brown leather jacket, paired with a **low-rise green sequined skirt** layered over a frayed underskirt and tied at the waist with rope. A **pink suede overnight bag** added a surprising burst of color.
- A **navy pleated Harrington jacket** teamed with a burgundy sequin skirt and a low-slung logo belt.
- A **cream tuxedo blazer** matched with a cream skirt decorated with green floral decals, offering a softer yet refined take on Britcore.
