

Bvlgari's Serpenti Infinito Exhibition at NMACC Mumbai

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From October 2 to 17, 2025, the Nita Mukesh Ambani Cultural Centre (NMACC) in Mumbai will host Bvlgari's acclaimed **Serpenti Infinito** exhibition. This marks the third chapter of a global showcase that began in Shanghai and Seoul, celebrating the Year of the Snake and the 75th anniversary of Bvlgari's iconic Serpenti collection.
