

Pierpaolo Piccioli Brings Poetry and Precision to Balenciaga: ‘The Heartbeat’ Marks a New Era of Chic

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Madrid — Just fifteen minutes. That’s all **Pierpaolo Piccioli** needed to redefine **Balenciaga’s identity** and close the sixth day of **Paris Fashion Week** with a masterstroke of elegance. In his debut as the new **creative director** of the historic French house with Spanish roots, Piccioli delivered a collection that merged **emotion, heritage, and innovation** — reclaiming the “chic” sophistication once synonymous with **Cristóbal Balenciaga** himself.
