Delicate Detailing

The sari was crafted from **georgette fabric**, giving it fluidity and elegance. Its borders featured **scalloped edges** and were embellished with **zardozi and sequin work**. Styling with Restraint

To let the sari take centre stage, Fatima paired it with a **matching sleeveless blouse** with a V neckline. The blouse was clean in cut, accented with **delicate gold buttis** that echoed the sari's detailing.

Overall jewellery thoughtfully chosen. She wore stacked drop earrings along with a **statement ring**. The ring was set with **Afghan lapis lazuli** and **Congolese malachite**. The rounded shapes of the jewellery mirrored the motifs on the sari's border.

Beauty & Finish

Fatima's hair was parted sharply and tied into a **neat bun**, maintaining the elegance of the overall look. However her makeup defined — rosy cheeks, **winged eyeliner**, and a satin nude lip. This beauty styling framed the face while letting the bold blue shine.

The Aesthetic & Takeaway

The final result was a perfect blend of boldness and restraint. The cobalt blue dominated. Thus gold work enriched. And the styling ensured nothing competed. Vogue noted that this look encapsulates Raw Mango's ethos: vivid palettes with pared-back, considered detailing.
