Later, Lee switched into a second, more sculptural suit — this time from **The Row's Winter 2025** line. Firstly the silhouette was sharply contoured: an hourglass blazer in deep black, paired with matching leggings. Secondly crisp white shirt peeked from beneath. To round off the look, she wore **burgundy-lens sunglasses** and left the bottom jacket button undone.

This second outfit leaned into a futuristic minimalism that echoed current runway trends — structure over flourish, precision over excess.
