Vedang's first major role was **Reggie Mantle** in *The Archies* (2023), directed by Zoya Akhtar. He followed that with *Jigra* (2024), playing Ankur Anand, a character with big dreams in difficult circumstances.

Though neither role put him as the central protagonist, critics and fans alike noticed his ability to leave an impression. His performances show emotional range and maturity.

A Craft with Intention

In his interview, Vedang Raina stresses he doesn't pick roles just for success or glamour. For him, what matters most is the **script and emotional challenge**.

He describes his preparation process in *Jigra*, where he spends hours mentally inhabiting the character before shooting. This discipline, paired with his artistic curiosity, is part of why he's gaining respect beyond looks.

Style, Personality & Fashion as An Identity

Apart from his performances, Vedang is also building a style persona. In the cover shoot for *The Peacock Magazine*, shot at City Palace, Jaipur, he paired regal aesthetics with modern flair—oversized shirts, baggy clothes, and minimal-vet-bold fashion choices.

He describes his own style as **minimalist**—preferring clean lines and tones over loud embellishments—but isn't afraid to experiment.
