- She completed the look with a **top-knot bun**, which elevated the neckline and allowed the pearl detail to take center stage.

Accessories appear minimal in images, which allowed her blouse and saree to be focal points rather than competing elements.

Styling & Aesthetic Choices

- Hair & Makeup: The top-knot bun gave her silhouette a vertical lift, while keeping the face visible and clean. Her makeup appears polished but not heavy glowy skin, defined eyes, and neutral lips.
- Balance & Contrast: The interplay between the rich pearl-embellished blouse and the flowing silk saree managed to balance bold ornamentation with soft drape. The use of a single statement blouse worked well to anchor the look.
