What Are Tulle Nails?

The term "tulle" instantly conjures sheer lace or airy veils. Similarly, tulle nails aim for a **delicate veil of color**, not a full, opaque coat.

They use very fine, slightly translucent polish. Sometimes the tint is milky white, pale pink, lavender, or soft nude. The color floats gently over the natural nail.

You might apply one thin coat, or layer two or three for more saturation. The effect remains light rather than heavy.

Softens Imperfections

Because the polish is sheer, it blurs minor ridges or texture on the nail. The look feels softer and more forgiving.

Aging Gracefully

With darker shades, chips or wear are obvious. Tulle nails tend to fade subtly — the wear blends, making it less noticeable.

Versatility

They match anything. Whether your outfit is bold or muted, tulle nails remain understated and complementary.

Transition-Friendly

If you're not quite ready for dark autumn hues, tulle nails serve as a soft bridge between summer brightness and fall richness.
