How the Reinvention Is Happening

1. Design innovation

Designers are experimenting with silhouettes — moving from traditional shirts and kurtas to dresses, jackets, trousers, even utilitarian separates. The cuts lean more streamlined, sometimes mixing western tailoring with handwoven panels.

2. **Modern dyeing & prints**

Natural dyes and muted colors, along with digital prints, are introduced. This keeps the fabric's texture visible while offering more versatility in styling.

3. **Brand-artisan collaborations**

Small labels, cooperatives, and individual weavers are partnering with fashion designers and urban boutiques. This gives artisans access to better tools, better markets, and design inputs that align with contemporary tastes.

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
