How to Do Aura Nails: A Quick Guide

- 2. Use a sponge or airbrush to dab on a secondary colour (or multiple colours) in the centre of the nail and gently blend outward to create the halo/gradient effect.
- 3. If using eyeshadow instead of polish: choose matte shades (avoid very glittery ones), apply carefully and dust off excess.
- 4. Finish with a top coat to smooth everything out and add seal. Gel polish can be used for longer wear.

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
