- If you pick a **sheer or glossy lip**, allow your blush to be slightly more pronounced—layer a cream blush, then set the perimeter with a light powder blush for longevity.
- Consider **harmonised tones**: If your lipstick leans warm (orange-red), pick a blush with warm undertones. If your lip is cool (berry or plum), select a blush with a similar cool cast.
- Finish with a touch of highlighter or glowy setting spray to give your look a festive "light-catching" effect—just enough shimmer to sparkle under ambient lights.
