

Nysa & Orry reimagine Kajol & Rekha's Iconic 1996 Photoshoot

Revisiting a legendary moment

The original photoshoot for Cineblitz in 1996 featured Kajol and Rekha in an oversized off-shoulder sweater, posing together in ways that were daring for its time.

In their version: Nysa steps into her mother Kajol's place, while Orry channels Rekha's persona—including pose, expression and attitude. They aren't simply copying; they're reinterpreting.

The Gen Z twist

While staying faithful to wardrobe, lighting and mood, the pair add a playful, updated spin. In an Instagram Reel released ahead of Halloween 2025, the visuals capture preparation, styling and the final frames. Orry captioned the post: "Genz equivalent of the (2/7 HW'25)" — cryptic yet clearly signalling generational shift.

The post sparked praise from fans, celebrities and social-media watchers, noting especially how Nysa resembles Kajol and how Orry nails Rekha's magnetism.
