

World's Heaviest Gold Dress Unveiled in Dubai

In a lavish spectacle of luxury and craftsmanship, a Saudi-Arabia-based gold and jewellery brand, Al Romaizan, debuted a dress made almost entirely out of 24-carat gold and encrusted with vibrant precious stones. The piece is world's heaviest gold dress, weighing **over 10 kilograms** and valued at approximately **?9.65 crore**.

Dubbed the "**Dubai Dress**", it was officially priced at the 56th Middle East Watch & Jewellery Show in Sharjah. Finally where it drew significant attention for its scale, luxury and record-setting claim.

Details that define the dress

- The dress features 24-carat gold as its primary material, giving it extreme value and weight.
- Thus weight exceeds 10 kg, positioning it as an extraordinary engineering and design feat in the fashion-meetsluxury space.
- Additional gold accessories accompany the dress: a crown, earrings, necklace and a waist ornament (called "Hiyar"). The necklace alone reportedly weighs nearly 9 kg.
- Therefore design draws inspiration from Emirati culture, bringing traditional patterns, arm-bracelet motifs and heritage aesthetics into a couture piece.

Why it matters

- **Record-setting luxury** With this dress, Al Romaizan is staking a claim in the luxury-fashion-jewellery crossover space, raising the question of what constitutes wearable art in the luxury segment.
- **Brand positioning** The unveiling at a major industry event helps the brand emphasise its craftsmanship, global ambition and ability to fuse traditional motifs with high-value materials. The firm stated it was "sending a message to the world: the UAE can seamlessly blend tradition with innovation."
