The look: tailoring meets modern minimalism

- The styling leaned minimal in accessories yet refined—jewellery was present but understated, balancing rather than competing with the outfit.

Why this choice works

- Authority in style: As Style Icon, Patel's look needed to speak of leadership. A structured, modern outfit achieved this much better than overt embellishment might have.
- Alignment with her story: Known as an entrepreneur, philanthropist and couture collector, her outfit bridged corporate polish and fashion cred.
- **Red-carpet relevance**: The awards event demanded glamour, but in a way that felt current and intentional. Patel struck that balance—refined yet impactful.
- Less is more: By focusing on silhouette and presence rather than heavy ornament, she stood out for maturity and thoughtful style rather than theatricality.
