

Dia Mirza's Rs 54.5 k Zari-Linen Ensemble: Quiet Luxury at Its Best

The Ensemble Breakdown

- **Pants:** Matching tapered pants in the same zari-linen fabric maintain cohesion and modern tailoring.
- **Dupatta:** A contrasting Topaz-hued linen dupatta with delicate gota and kinari work rounds off the set—bringing traditional detail into a minimalist story.
- **Styling details:** Finally she paired the ensemble with minimalist jewellery, a subtle red bindi and soft makeup, allowing the rich fabric and colour to take centre stage. Her choice of dark-green sandals provided just enough contrast.
