Apparel: Modern Silhouettes with Heritage Details

On the apparel front, the collection presents garments that reflect the riot of Jaipur's colour palette and architectural rhythm, but in modern cuts and fabrics. Thus the idea was to keep the legacy alive without making wearers feel like they are stepping into a costume. By combining heritage prints, artisanal embellishments and modern tailoring, the garments become functional pieces of fashion grounded in culture.

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
