

Stewart Celebrates Directorial Win in Super-Sheer Rodarte

At the 2025 SCAD Savannah Film Festival in Savannah, Georgia, Kristen Stewart was honoured with the **Rising Star Director Award** for her debut directorial feature, The Chronology of Water.

She did more than accept an award — she made a strong style statement.

The Sheer Look: Bold, Unmistakable

For the red carpet, Stewart wore a white-lace ensemble by Rodarte (Spring/Summer 2025 runway piece) composed of a long-sleeve blouse with frilly cuffs and open collar, tied at the chest, and a matching high-waisted midi skirt in sheer lace fabric.

The styling added a twist of contrast: visible black lace underwear beneath the white lace layers, black heels, and a silver chain with a lock pendant.

Her hair was in a messy up-do and her makeup included a dramatic smokey eye to balance the softness of the lace.

Additionally, the festival appearance included a second sheer look — a button-down tailored set by Dzojchen featuring a bra top and velvet mini skirt, paired with Dr. Martens boots and sunglasses.

Style Significance

- The use of **sheer lace** makes the outfit visually striking it plays with transparency, layering, and contrast (white lace + black under-garment) to blend elegance and edge.
- By choosing Rodarte's runway piece, Stewart aligns her director persona with fashion haute couture rather than traditional red-carpet glamour.
- Also visible underwear detail flagged as a Y2K revival trend the "lingerie as outerwear" move resurfacing in high fashion.
- Therefore bold fashion choice mirrors her professional pivot (from actor to director), signalling confidence, self-expression and that she's forging a new identity.
