

Janhvi Kapoor Dazzles in Cobalt Patola Lehenga

Janhvi Kapoor made a striking fashion statement in a vivid cobalt-blue **Patola Lehenga**, masterfully styled by her team for a recent wedding/celebration. According to *Vogue India*, the ensemble celebrated Indian maximalism through its use of colour, traditional technique and layered adornment.

The base fabric referenced the hand-woven Patola motif, while the blouse and ghagra incorporated rich mirror-work, Parsi gara floral embroidery, clusters of Basra pearls and bead-tassels.

Contrasting Elements & Accessory Story

What makes this look particularly powerful is its contrast-play. The cobalt lehenga is paired with a striking pink dupatta, which introduces a fresh colour-counterpoint and botanical embroidery. Meanwhile, the dupatta border with metallic coins adds movement and texture.

Accessories elevate the drama further: gemstone-embedded silver jewellery, a silver minaudière with turquoise/blush stones, oxidised rings, a broad cuff, and even ornate hair-brooches. The jewellery vocabulary echoes the outfit's maximalist ethos.

Craft, Heritage & Styling Notes

The ensemble places heritage textiles and craft techniques centre-stage. Patola weaving, Parsi gara embroidery and Basra pearls all point to a deep engagement with Indian textile traditions. Yet the styling remains wholly contemporary—bold, expressive and tailor-made for a glamorous festive moment.

Beauty and styling follow suit: a warm makeup palette, velvet-matte pink lips, a small bindi and kohl-rimmed eyes complete the look—ensuring harmony between outfit and face.

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
