

Kate Middleton's Tribute Look at 2025 Festival of Remembrance

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On 8 November 2025, Kate Middleton, the Princess of Wales, attended the annual Festival of Remembrance at the Royal Albert Hall in London. The event—organised by the Royal British Legion—honours the service and sacrifice of British and Commonwealth Armed Forces personnel and their families.

Joining senior royals including King Charles III and Queen Camilla, Middleton arrived with her eldest son, Prince George.

Style That Speaks Volumes

For the occasion, Kate selected a black midi dress by Alessandra Rich, featuring a striking white lace-trimmed collar and peplum styling.

Her accessories carried deep symbolism:

- A handmade red poppy pin (the official symbol of remembrance).
- The HMS Glasgow brooch by James Porter & Son.
- The Bahrain pearl drop earrings once worn by Queen Elizabeth II, and a diamond cross pendant, nods to royal heritage.

Introducing the Heir in a New Role

Prince George's presence alongside his mother marked a notable moment. Dressed formally with poppy pin and striped tie, the 12-year-old stepped into a public duty role under the royal umbrella.

His attendance not only symbolises continuity of royal engagement but also underscores the family's commitment to remembrance traditions.

The Broader Significance

This Festival held additional meaning: marking the 80 th anniversary of the end of World War II and recognising the contributions.
