

Brow Serums in 2026: Benefits, Uses and Top Picks

Most serums contain a combination of:

- **Biotin (Vitamin B7)** — strengthens keratin and hair structure.
- **Panthenol (Vitamin B5)** — conditions and moisturises hair.
- **Natural oils or botanical extracts** — nourish and protect brows.
