You can use them **before makeup application** to prep the skin or **midday as needed** to refresh your look without a full touch?up.

Beauty experts often recommend blotting papers for people whose skin produces a lot of natural oils, especially in warm or humid climates. They're also a handy travel essential for events, photoshoots or long workdays when a flawless complexion matters.
