

## Saif Ali Khan Makes Bold Style Move with ₹42 Lakh Brooch in Mumbai

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Bollywood actor **Saif Ali Khan** made a striking style declaration during a recent outing in Mumbai, elevating men's fashion by embracing an extravagant luxury brooch — a trend previously popularised by industrialist **Anant Ambani** on high-profile occasions. By choosing this eye-catching brooch for a relatively casual public appearance, Khan underscored how **luxury jewellery is no longer confined to formal red carpets or traditional attire**. Fashion insiders suggest that male accessories — including high-end brooches — are increasingly viewed as expressions of personality and refined style rather than gender-specific adornments, helping to expand the range of mainstream men's fashion.
